

History of the Village of Waterloo

In 1799 an Act of Parliament was passed authorising the cutting of a new road from Ashton to Oldham, with the new road being constructed in stages from 1820.

The village of Waterloo was first recorded in 1816, being named after the victory in the Crimean War in June 1815. This newly formed part of Taunton was a growing community at the time. The only way in and out of Waterloo was via Cow Lane (Ney Street) down to Taunton Platting.

By 1823 it was recorded that Waterloo was no longer a cul de sac, and consisted of neatly built cottages and a school.
