DID YOU KNOW?

Waterloo and Taunton Conservative Club was designed by architects John Eaton and Sons, Ashton-under-Lyne.

John Eaton and Sons also designed the Children's Hospital at Ashton General Hospital (1892), Ashton Library, Hurst Cross, Hartshead Pike, Christ Church Schools, the Lych Gate at St Paul's Stalybridge, Ashton Armoury (1887), the boathouse, ticket office and tool house at Stamford Park, and Dukinfield Town Hall (1901).

Following the design of Waterloo and Taunton Conservative Club, the process was put out for tender.

Bids to erect were received by the first Club Secretary 'Mr Aaron Williamson', and ranged between £1,050 to £1,224.

John Eaton became a member of the Club on 11th December 1883. He was proposed by Aaron Williamson and seconded by Walter Smith.

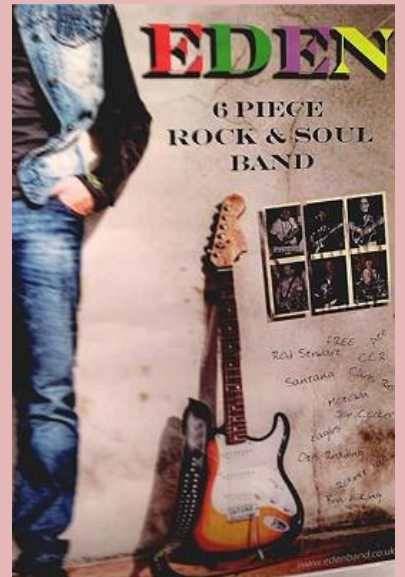
