DID YOU KNOW?

Have you ever heard of **Swinecote Hall**?

Located across from Littlemoss, behind Newmarket, near Lower Crowhill Farm (roughly where Richmond Running Track / Curzon Ashton stands today).

It was an ancient stone building that became a tavern.

Because of its Thatched roof, it became known as 'Owed Thatched Tavern'.

It was said to be a 'hush shop' where liquor was sold without a licence. It became licenced in 1830, but lost it in 1873.

Swinecote Hall was gutted by a fire in 1908 and was later pulled down.
